

1. Bowlers must have a current USBC card.
2. ENTERING AVERAGE. All bowlers' average will be determined in the following manner: Bowlers will use their highest verifiable average on the USBC website (bowl.com) for the 2017-2018 winter or summer season of 21 games or more or their composite average higher. Bowlers who do not have an average through USBC for the 2017-2018 season will use their highest current league average of 21 games or more as of February 2, 2019. A standing sheet of the week 2/2/19 MUST be presented at check-in. Those not meeting this requirement must bowl scratch. HANDICAP will be 80% from 210 average.
3. VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING RULES COULD BE CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION AND THE LOSS OF PRIZE MONEY:
 - a. The 10-Pin Rule will be in effect, USBC Rule 319/a/2 – If current average as of 2/2/19 is 10 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used.
 - b. USBC Rule #13 will be in effect for unmarried, grade and high school students.
 - c. Each bowler will be responsible for the accurate entering of his/her average, regardless of who may have submitted same. If a lower average is used, bowler will be disqualified.
 - d. USBC Rule 319c. Bowler must report any previous tournament average adjustment/re-rate.
 - e. USBC Rule 319d. Reporting prior prize winnings. Bowlers who have qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize within the last 12 months in the categories listed must report those amount to the Tournament Director prior to participation for possible average adjustment.
 1. \$300 or more in any event.
 2. Total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament.
 3. Total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12 months.
4. Any bowling ball that has two weight holes is not allowed. If a ball is drilled for a thumb hole and also has a balance weight hole, that ball is not allowed if the bowler does not use the thumb hole for gripping, thus creating two weight holes. Tournament Director may check any bowling ball for USBC specification at any time during the tournament.
5. In the event of breakdown of pin-setting equipment or scoring devise, the bowler may be moved to first available lanes, or may bowl out on one lane if a pair of lanes is not available. Failure of the scoring device shall not void scores of games already completed but shall cause the game underway to be re-bowled, if the game status cannot be recreated through the automatic scoring equipment data file.
6. SUBSTITUTIONS will not be allowed, however, no change in the line-up position of the person being replaced will be allowed. All substitutions will be made at the direction of the Tournament Director and should be made at least 30 minutes before squad times.

7. One (1) Cash prize for each eight (8) entries in Team, Doubles and Singles. Per Rule 308, all prize fees collected in an event will be returned 100% to the participants in that event.
8. Late Arrivals – Check in begins 30 minutes before each squad time. Any bowler arriving after the start of their scheduled squad must start in the frame being bowled when they arrive.
9. Entry fee will be paid by Credit Card (online web page), or Cashier's Check or Money Order (Payable to Feed the Children). All Cashier's Checks or Money Orders can be mailed to Feed the Children, Attn: Bowling Tournament, 333 N. Meridian Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.
10. Team shall consist of 4 members, any combination of men or women.
11. MULTIPLE ENTRIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.
12. Entry deadline is July 1, 2019. Any entry received after that date is assessed a \$20 administrative fee.
13. ALL-EVENTS: Bowlers can have their scores counted towards an All-Events Prize IF entered and paid for prior to the start of the Team Event. All-Events. This will be done during the day of the event, at the bowling center.
14. Substitutes will be eligible to participate in (All-Events) competition ONLY if the substitute is for the same person in team, doubles and singles AND the original member has prepaid for the All-Events prior to the start of the Team Event.
15. All rules not here mentioned fall under the USBC 2018-2019 Rule Book.
